


# How to Download and Set Up Zapier Application with Translate.com

## 1. Visit the Zapier Website

1.1. Follow the link <https://zapier.com/app/login>

1.2. Click on "Sign Up" in the top-right corner. You can sign up with your Google or Microsoft account, or you can create an account using your email and password.

## 2. Explore the Dashboard




2.1. Once you're logged in, you'll be directed to the Zapier dashboard, where you can create "Zaps" (automation between different apps).

## 3. Create Your First Zap


3.1. Click on "Create a Zap"



3.2. Choose a Trigger App (the app that starts the automation) and set the event.




3.3. Zapier supports thousands of apps, making it a multi-tool for integrating across different platforms




## 4. Choose an Action App (Translate.com (1.0.1)).


For the action, select Translate.com (1.0.1) as the app to connect your target with and initiate the translation process.

4.1. Click on the “**Action App**” field and choose **Translate.com (1.0.1)** from the list of available options.




4.2. For an **“Action event,”** choose a machine or human translation. The “Account” tab will fill automatically. Once you’ve completed the setup, proceed to the Configure section.





**4.3. Select the source and target languages for the translation. For the text, click the + icon and choose the trigger you previously set up. After, proceed to the Test section.**

**4.4. Push a Test button, and after the text is translated push a Publish button**



## 5. Choose an Action App (the app that takes action after the translation) and set the event.

### 5.1. Choose the Action App:

After the trigger and the translation are set, choose an app where the action will occur (e.g., add the translation to a Google Sheet/Document, etc.).

### 5.2. Choose Action Event:

Select the specific action that should happen (e.g., add a new document/spreadsheet row, etc.).

### 5.3. Customize the Action:

Set up how the action should be performed based on the data from the trigger (e.g., in a Google Sheets action, specify the exact columns for new data to be inserted).


### 5.4. Test the Action:

Zapier allows you to send test data to ensure that the action is working as intended. You can then check your connected apps to verify the results.

## 6. Turn On the Zap

### 6.1. Turn on Your Zap:

Once everything is set up and tested, click “Turn on Zap” to activate your
